


WHAT'S IN THE KIT?

- I x Aluminium Turbo Elbow
- I x Silicone step down hose
- b 1 x M6 Cap Head Screw
- ▷ 1 x 50-70mm Hose Clip
- ▷ 1 x 70-90mm Hose Clip

REQUIRED TOOLS AND PARTS

- ⊳ T30 Torx Bit
- ⊳ 5 mm Allen
- Screwdriver/7mm Hex Socket
- ▷ OEM Hose Clip Remover





FITTING INSTRUCTIONS VWR12UPITINLET

Step 1:

Removal of OEM Air Filter Box - Using a T30 Torx bit unscrew the self tapping screw at the front of the air box, detach left and right hand hoses and using a OEM hose clip remover detach clip at the rear of the air filter box. Pull the OEM Air Filter Box up to detach from OEM turbo elbow and remove from vehicle.

Step 2:

Removal of OEM Turbo Elbow - Disconnect the hose from beneath the turbo elbow, then using a T30 Torx bit unscrew the captive screw located on the engine side of the OEM turbo elbow and then remove the elbow.

Step 3:

Installation of RacingLine Turbo Elbow & Silicone – Offer up RacingLine turbo elbow, ensuring the pin is inserted in the turbo's locating hole. Insert M6 screw and tighten down (Ensuring turbo elbow is straight and seats flush to the turbo). Loosely attach hose clips to Silicone step down hose before placing on turbo outlet, leave clips loose so silicone hose can be rotated to line up with the OEM Air Filter Box.

Step 4:

Re-install OEM Air Filter Box - Offer the air box onto the engine, inserting the air box outlet into the Silicone step down hose. Once in place orientate the hose until it sits correctly, once happy with hose orientation tighten hose clips. Then repeat step 1 in reverse, attach right and left hand hoses and screw T30 self tapping screw back in to finalise the fitment.

Vehicle suitability note:

This RacingLine 1.0 TSI Turbo Elbow does not fit vehicles with 04C 129 654 A This variant of turbo elbow can be identified as it has two Norma fitting outlets, which are highlighted in figure 3.
